**Child presents at
A&E**

Acute medical care

**Ready for discharge –
is follow-up needed?**

**Discharge to
GP**

'Yes'
e.g. recurrent events
unusual events
family anxiety ++

'No'
e.g. single event
recurrent febrile convulsions
no other concerns

Consider:
Blood sugar / calcium
ECG
Discussion with A&E/Paed senior
Request camcorder video of future events
