Bolton Council's Start Well Service, working closely with the Public Health Nursing service (health visitors) will be offering an extra developmental check for 18-month-old children (for all families with children not being seen by a Public Health Nurse).









The 18-month old check will:

- · Follow on from your child's nine to 12-month assessment
- Be carried out by a qualified early years practitioner with a wealth of experience in child development and supporting families
- · Take place in your home (unless this is not convenient for you)

It is an opportunity to review with you, your child's:

- · Social, emotional and behavioural development
- Communication and language development
- General development
- · Any other concerns you may have

The check will be shared with your specialist public health nurse (health visitor).

When will checks begin?



Initially in two neighbourhoods, **Turton and Rumworth**



Checks will be rolled out across **Bolton**

You'll receive an invitation to take up the offer of an 18-month-old check from a Start Well early years practitioner by letter or telephone from the dates above.

This assessment is being completed in line with what other local authorities in Greater Manchester currently offer.
