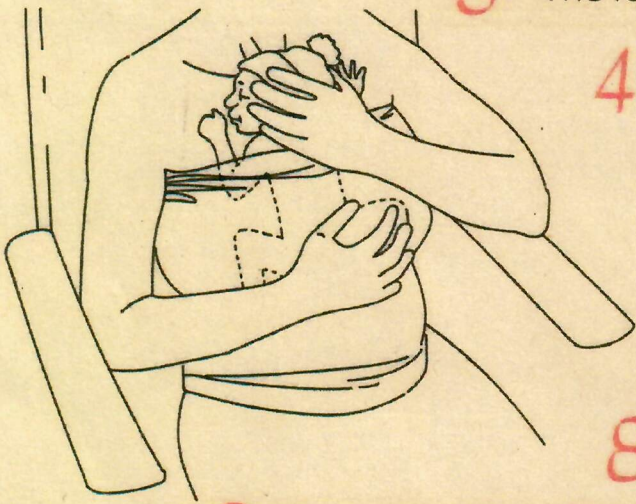


PROPER KANGAROO CARE POSITION

- 1 The baby is upright, centered on the adult's chest.
- 2 The top of the baby's head is at the level of the adult's clavicle.
- 3 The face to one side, uncovered and unobstructed.
- 4 The baby's torso is aligned and centered from the top of the head to the tailbone.
- 5 The baby and adult's chests are bare and touching each other skin-to-skin.
- 6 The arms are flexed to each side.
- 7 The baby's hands are by the mouth.
- 8 The diaper stops at the baby's navel.
- 9 The legs are flexed, to the sides with the toes pointing outwards.
- 10 To use your hands for other tasks, close the zipper when The Zaky ZAK® properly maintains the baby's weight and posture.
